In 2011 she was co-responsible of the archaeological excavation in the Necropolis of Malignano (Siena), under the direction of Soprintendenza per i Beni Archeologici della Toscana, and since 2013 she is responsible of the classification of materials from the excavation of University of Pavia in the Iron Age settlement of Verucchio (RN).

Her interests concern mostly the study of the ceramic productions in the ancient northern Etruria during the Hellenistic period, with focus on the black-glazed ware of Volterra area. She mainly focuses her studies on the methodological aspects and on the new technology of the archaeological research.
