Manuela Verri received her degree of scientific maturity (marks: 60/60) in 1992. She received her degree in Biological Sciences, with honours, at the University of Pavia in the academic year 1996/1997. In the academic year 1999/2000 she was a Ph.D. student in Neurobiology: a collaboration among the University of Catania, the University of Pavia and University "La Sapienza" in Rome. Studies took place for 4 years. In the academic year 2002/2003 she received her Ph.D. in Neurobiology at the University of Catania. In 2004 she received a three month grant from the Salvatore Maugeri Foundation in Nervi, Genova. In the same year she received a Post Doc grant (duration of four years) within the Department of Physiological and Pharmacological Sciences, University of Pavia.

Actually she's a research technician within the Department of Biology and Biotechnology "Lazzaro Spallanzani", University of Pavia. Her main interest areas include human and animal studies (bioenergetic of ageing and neurodegenerative disorders, and inflammatory bowel diseases) and in vitro studies (biocompatibility and cytotoxicity tests). The research activity is documented by 40 scientific publications in international journals. She is member of the following academic societies: Italian Society of Pharmacology (SIF) and Italian Society of Toxicology (SITOX). Since October 1, 2016 she is Contract Professor in Toxicology and Safety of Biotechnological Products (3 CFU), of the second cycle degree course in Advanced Biotechnology.
