Maria Pia Riccardi is an Associate Professor at the Department of Earth and Environmental Sciences of the University of Pavia and scientific director of the Pavia branch of the *Arvedi Laboratory of Diagnostics for Cultural Heritage*.

Her research activity takes place in a highly interdisciplinary field and covers issues related to the traceability of historical and archaeological artefacts. The archaeometric approach, interpreted in an innovative perspective to find the links between the artefacts (objects), the territories and the "know-how", has been applied to different classes of materials (stone, minerals, metals, ceramics, glass, pigments) and in different contexts. Since 2015, Riccardi participates in the international commission *UISPP* (International Union of Prehistoric and Protohistoric Sciences) - Archeometry of Pre- and Protohistoric Inorganic Artifacts, Materials and Technologies, as a member of the commission and as treasurer. Over the years, she has collaborated with the Ca' del Monte Astronomical Observatory, for scientific dissemination purposes; she participates to the PRISMA project.
